The AFRTC's effort is to focus elite athletes who aspire to become All-American, National, World, and Olympic champions in a single training complex. This focus provides a location for local athletes and the individuals and corporations who choose to support this noble and worthy initiative to pursue excellence.

The training complex is housed on the prestigious grounds of the United States Air Force Academy, in Colorado Springs, Colorado, neighboring the prestigious U.S. Olympic Training Center. Currently a core group of 60+ athletes within a 250 mile range of the United States Air Force Academy, who met the current USA Wrestling RTC criteria, participate in AFRTC events. The AFRTC athletes are from the United States Air Force Academy, a NCAA Division I institution in the Big 12 Wrestling Conference, the United States Air Force Preparatory School, the U.S. Olympic Training Center and local Colorado high schools.

Athletes who participate in the AFRTC benefit from the training offered in Freestyle and Greco-Roman wrestling, leadership development, warrior ethos, in a climate and culture of inclusion and respect, while training and competing at the highest level.

Waiver and Release from Liability

1. I, _____, the undersigned, on behalf of myself, my heirs and next of kin, personal representative, agents, insurers, successors and assigns (all hereinafter "Releasors") hereby FOREVER RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE AIR FORCE REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER, its insurers, its affiliated clubs, administrators, agents, directors, officers, state organizations, members, committees, volunteers, all employees of USA Wrestling, and any and all participants, officials, referees, coaches, host clubs, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, local organizing committees (and if applicable) owners, lessors and operators of premises used to conduct any USA Wrestling sanctioned event, meet, practice or activity (all hereinafter "Releasees") from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, causes of action or losses of any kind or nature, past, present or future, direct or consequential that I may hereafter have for PERSONAL INJURY, PERMANENT, TEMPORARY, TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY, DISFIGUREMENT, PARALYSIS AND ANY OTHER LOSSES OR DAMAGES TO PERSON OR PROPERTY OR DEATH, arising out of my participation in, attendance at or traveling to and from any USA Wrestling sanctioned event or activity including, but not limited to, LOSSES CAUSED BY THE PASSIVE OR ACTIVE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES, or hidden, latent or obvious defects in the facilities or equipment used.

2. Releasor understands and acknowledges that USA Wrestling sanctioned activities and the sport of wrestling in general have inherent dangers that no amount of care, caution, training, instruction, supervision or expertise can eliminate. RELEASOR EXPRESSLY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY, PERMANENT, TEMPORARY, TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY, DISFIGUREMENT, PARALYSIS AND ANY OTHER LOSSES OR DAMAGES TO PERSON OR PROPERTY OR DEATH, sustained while participating in, attending, preparing for or traveling to and from any USA Wrestling sanctioned event, meet, practice or activity, including the risk of PASSIVE OR ACTIVE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES, or hidden, latent or obvious defects in the facilities or equipment used.

3. Releasor acknowledges and fully understands that each participant in any USA Wrestling sanctioned event, meet, practice or activity, including Releasor, will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent, temporary, total or partial disability, disfigurement, paralysis and any other losses to person or property, including death, and that severe social and economic losses may result not only from releasor's own action, inactions or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions or negligence of other notwithstanding the rules of play or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further releasor acknowledges and fully understands that there may be other associated risks with such activities which are not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
